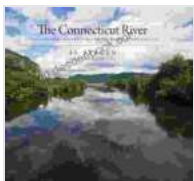


A Photographic Journey Into the Heart of New England Garnet Books

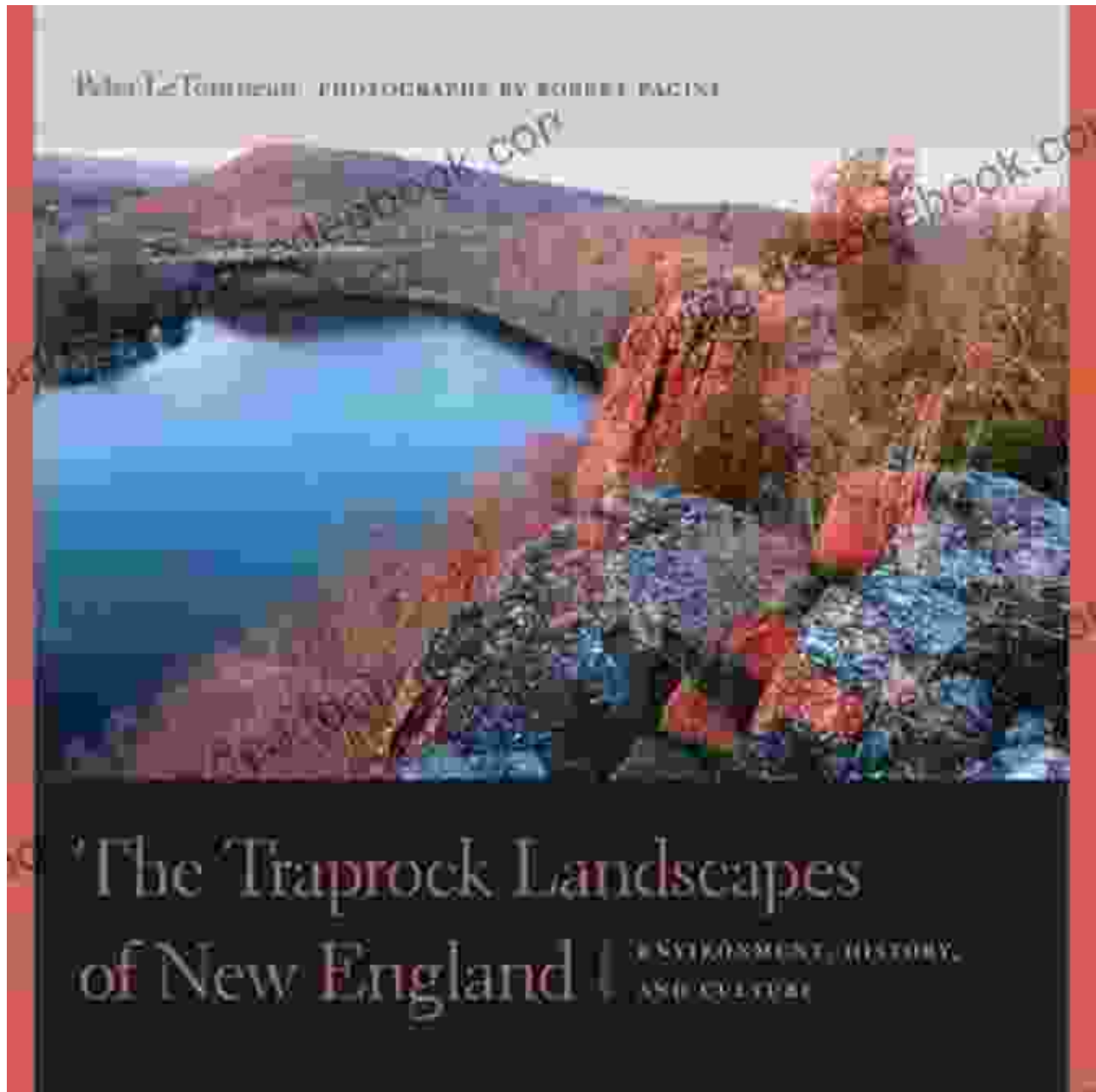

The Interior



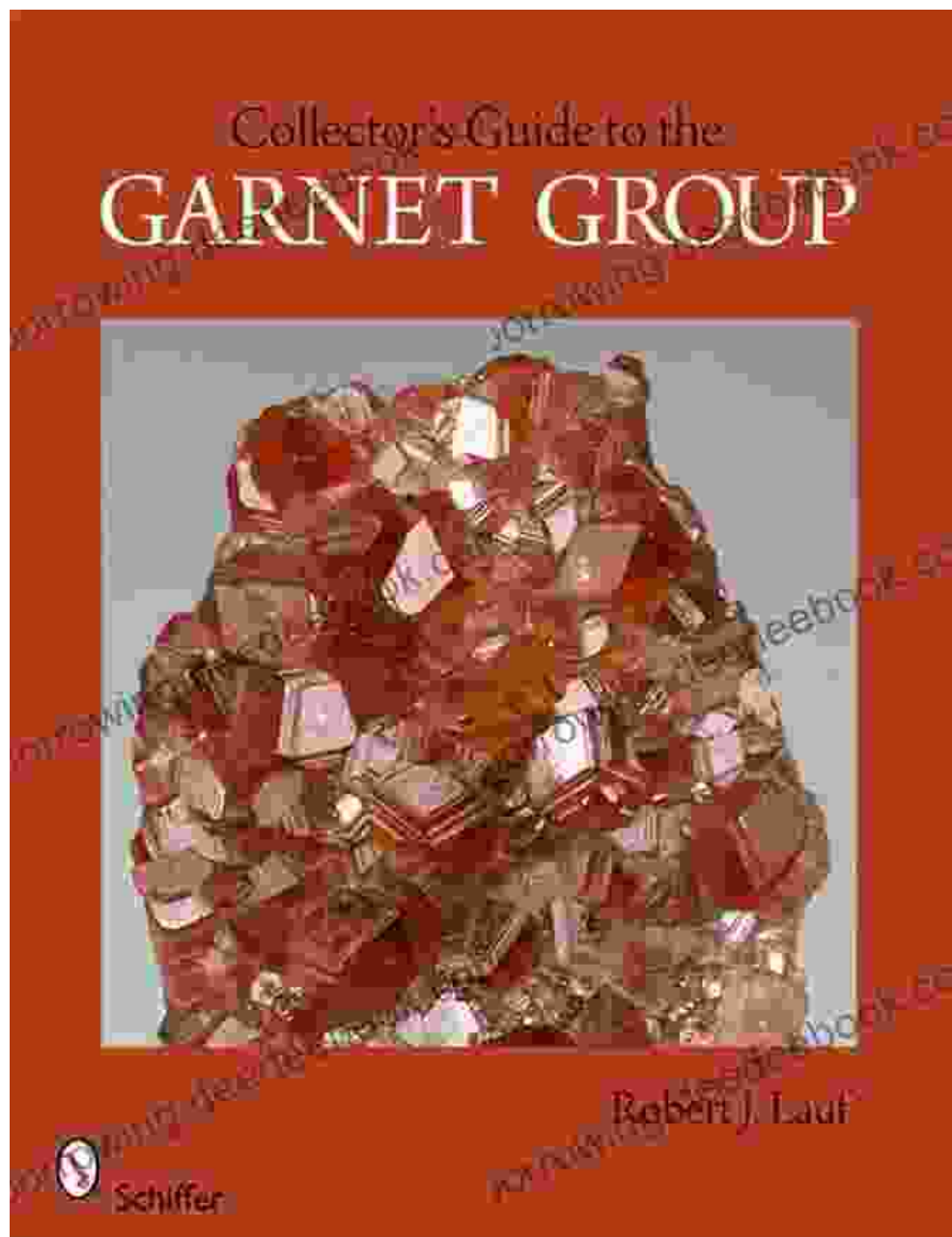
The interior of New England Garnet Books

The Customers

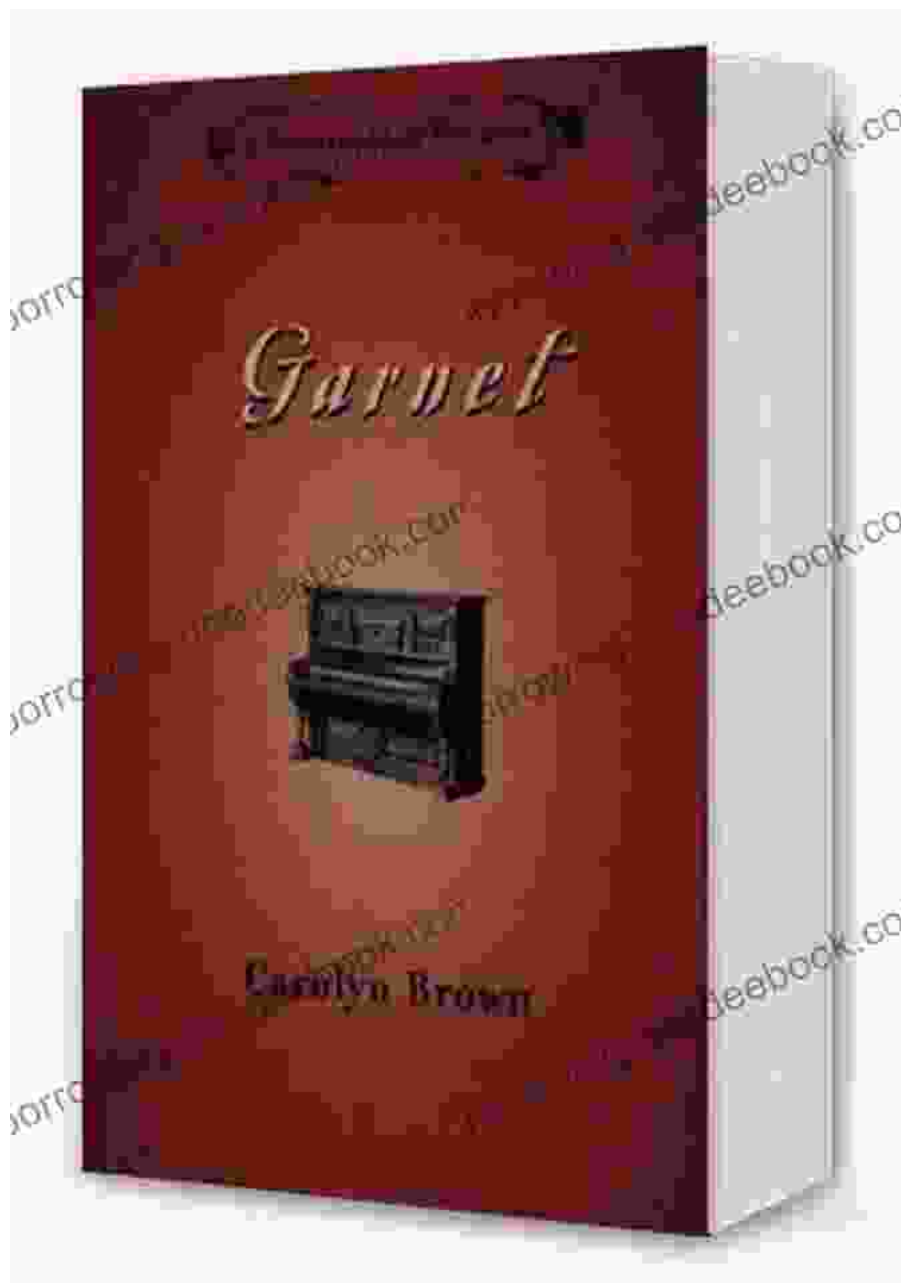


Customers browsing the shelves at New England Garnet Books

The Events



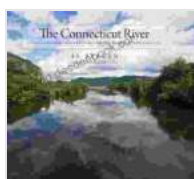

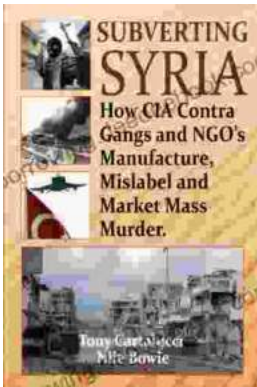
