

Pass Line Bet: This bet is made on the shooter rolling a 7 or 11 on the come-out roll. If the shooter rolls a 7 or 11, the bettor wins even money. If the shooter rolls a 2, 3, or 12, the bettor loses. If the shooter

rolls any other number, the point is established and the bettor wins if the shooter rolls the point number again before rolling a 7.

- Don't Pass Line Bet: This bet is the opposite of the pass line bet. The bettor wins if the shooter rolls a 2 or 3 on the come-out roll, and loses if the shooter rolls a 7 or 11. If the shooter rolls any other number, the point is established and the bettor wins if the shooter rolls a 7 before rolling the point number again.
- Come Bet: This bet is similar to the pass line bet, but it is made after the point has been established. The bettor wins if the shooter rolls the point number before rolling a 7.
- Don't Come Bet: This bet is the opposite of the come bet. The bettor wins if the shooter rolls a 7 before rolling the point number.
- **Field Bet:** This bet is made on the shooter rolling a 2, 3, 4, 9, 10, 11, or 12. The payout for a field bet is 1:1.
- **Horn Bet:** This bet is made on the shooter rolling a 2, 3, 11, or 12. The payout for a horn bet is 3:2.
- **Yo Bet:** This bet is made on the shooter rolling an 11. The payout for a yo bet is 15:1.

Odds of Winning in Craps



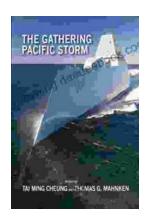

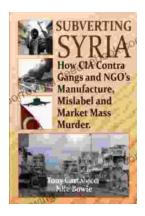
