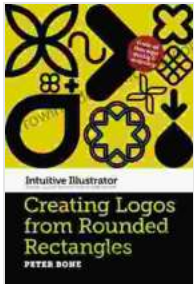

2. To change the thickness of the stroke, use the "Weight" option in the "Stroke" panel.

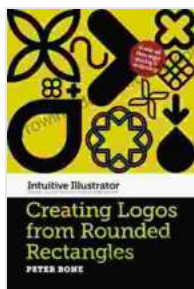
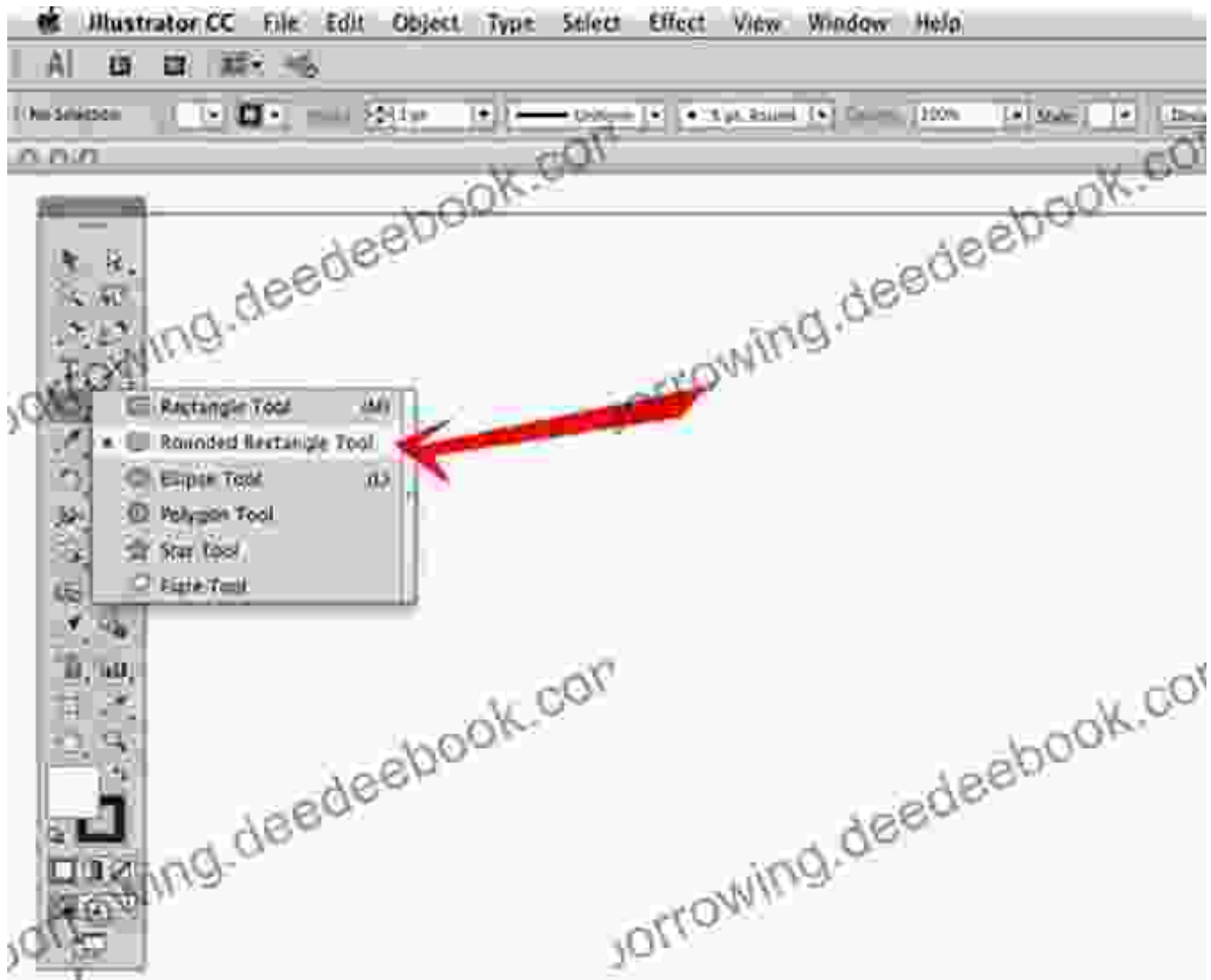
Step 6: Save Your Logo

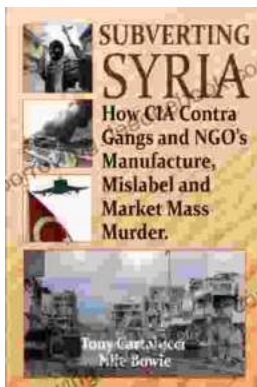
