

- 1. Ch 1, single crochet (sc) around the top edge of the booties, working 2 sc in each corner stitch.

- 2. Join with a sl st to the first sc.
- 3. Continue working in rounds of sc until the cuff reaches the desired height.
- 1. Fasten off the yarn and weave in any loose ends.
- 2. Embellish the booties with ribbons, buttons, or other decorative elements, if desired.
- Use high-quality yarn to ensure durability and comfort.
- Keep your stitches even and consistent throughout the project.
- Don't be afraid to adjust the pattern to fit your baby's feet.
- Make sure the booties are snug but not too tight, allowing for growth.



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
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
