


Steve Bannon





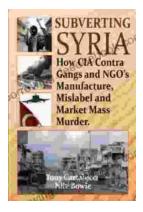
