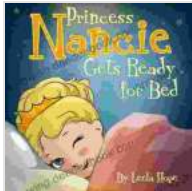


Princess Nancie Gets Ready for Bed

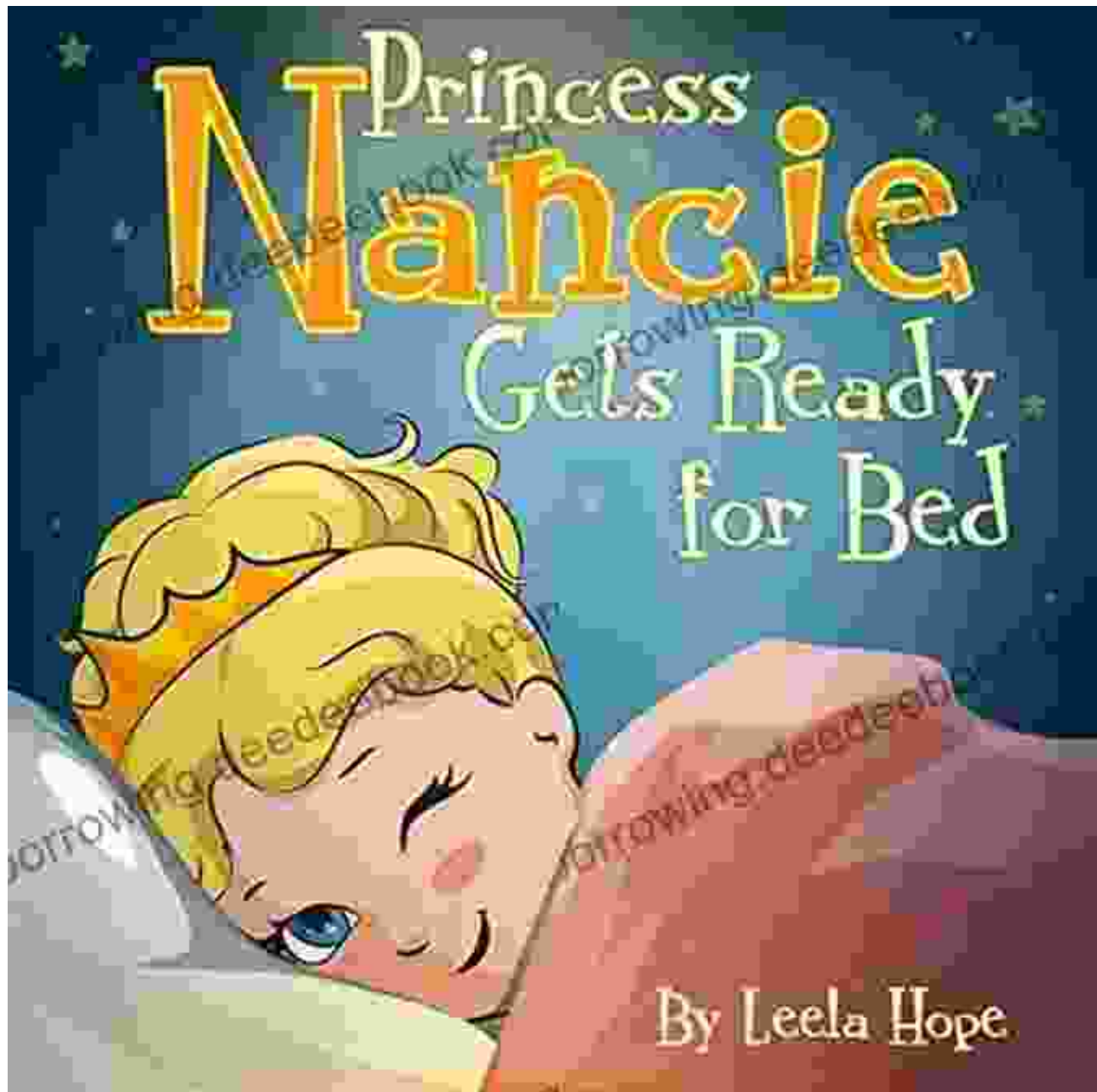

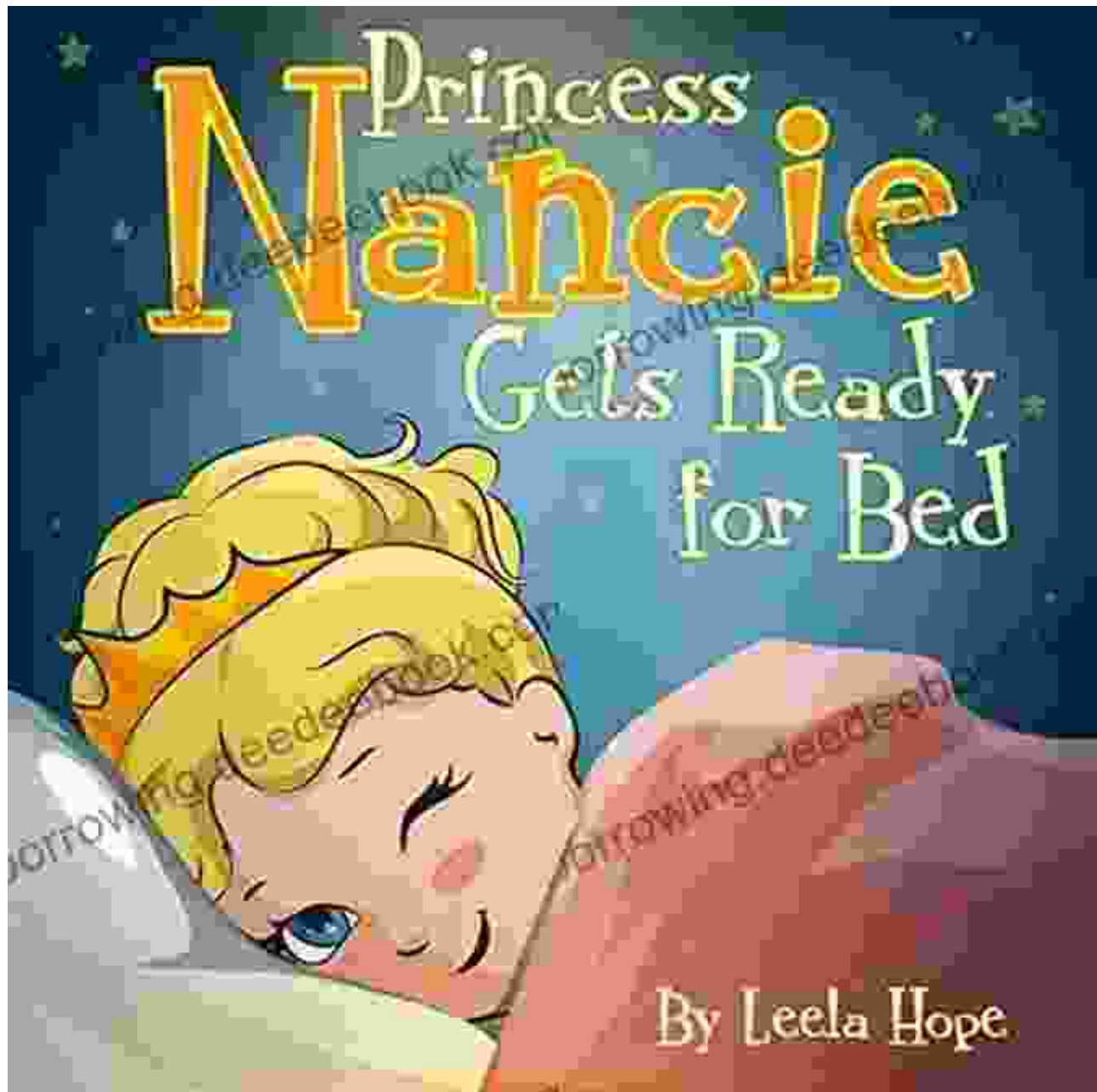

Good night, Princess Nancie. Sleep well.

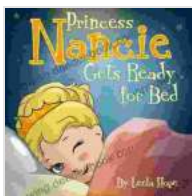

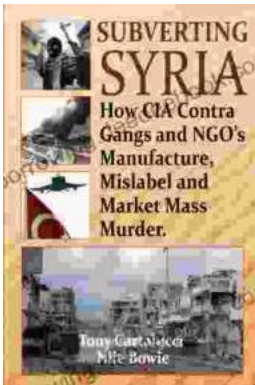
